

Tawd Vale Air Rifle and Field Target Club

Club Rules

These rules and the Club Safety Regulations shall form the “Rules of the Club” referred to in the Constitution.

1. All Committee decisions shall be binding on all members.
2. The Club Safety Regulations must be observed at all times.
3. All members shall ensure that their weapons are within legal limits and shall ensure that they are aware of and follow the law relating to use of Air Guns at ALL times.
4. **Membership**
 - a) There is no age limit, save that in the opinion of the committee, a person must be able to safely handle the gun they are using, and follow the Safety Regulations and instructions from the Marshalls.
 - b) Applicants for membership **MUST** make at least three shooting visits to the club before applying.
 - c) Membership will be granted by a quorum of the committee.
5. **Annual Subscriptions.**
 - a) Annual Membership fees, due dates and other fee levels (such as use of the club gun) will be decided at the AGM.
 - b) All members must pay their fees as soon as possible after they are due.
 - c) The committee reserve the right to cancel the membership of any person who in their opinion delays payment of fees excessively.

- 6. All members MUST sign in the attendance register upon arrival, whether they intend to shoot or not and regardless of the intended length of visit.**
 - 7. ALL accidents and any near accidents MUST be entered into the Accident book and a senior officer of the club notified.**
 - 8. Juniors under the age of 15 must be accompanied by a responsible adult over the age of 21.**
 - 9. Members are expected whenever possible to participate in club activities. This includes giving assistance in running the clubs activities and participating in those activities.**
 - 10. No liability whatsoever will be accepted by the club for loss or damage to member's property.**
 - 11. Instructions from the appointed Range Officer or Marshall must be obeyed at all times.**
 - 12. Any unsafe or unsatisfactory conduct will render the person responsible liable to dismissal from the club.**
 - 13. Any Person dismissed from the club can ask in writing that the decision to dismiss him be ratified at an Ordinary General Meeting of the Club. That meeting shall be called in the prescribed way by a request from Six existing members. The dismissed member shall have no automatic right of attendance at that meeting.**
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
